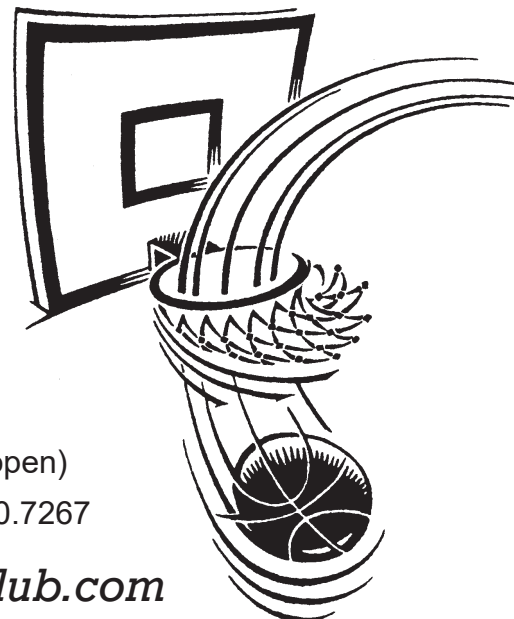


KEARNEY BASKETBALL CLUB SKILLS PROGRAM

This Waiver of Liability is intended to discharge in advance the coaches, officers, directors and sponsors of the Kearney Basketball Club, their heirs, and assigns from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected of or connected in any way with the participation of our child, _____, in the above described Kearney Basketball Club program even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities above and who are hereby released.

We further understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during basketball and basketball related activities and that participants in basketball related activities occasionally sustain serious or mortal personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risks of basketball related activities, nevertheless, we hereby agree to assume those risks and to release and hold harmless all of the persons and entities mentioned above who, through negligence, carelessness or otherwise, might be liable to us or our heirs or assigns for damages.

It is further understood that this Waiver, Release and Assumption of Risk is to be binding on our heirs and assigns.

TOURNAMENT TEAMS

The Kearney Basketball Club has made it one of our top objectives for the upcoming season to help more “tournament teams” form in Kearney, to play in area tournaments following the conclusion of the KBC Skills Program.

Often called “travelling teams,” basketball tournament teams are able, for the most part, to play in events that do not require much travel beyond the tri-cities area.

The KBC can help parents interested in this option by providing practice time, team uniforms, access to information on events in the area, and some assistance with organizing the team. **KBC does not form the teams**, it is up to the parents to put together a group of 8-10 kids who wish to play. Teams are formed in a variety of ways. The most common is a parent or two putting together a group of friends, or players that they know from KBC and other sports; sometimes it is eight kids from one elementary or middle school, some form with all KPS kids, some form with all KCHS students.

Kearney hosts two of the state’s biggest tournaments, and there are tournaments in Holdrege, Lexington, Ravenna & Cairo, Aurora, Grand Island, Hastings, Minden and Lincoln, that allow teams to play in several events with limited travel.

Most of these tournaments have multiple brackets for various levels of ability, so that no matter the strength of your team, they can play in a bracket where they will be competitive.

Parents normally split up the entry fees for the tournaments. The total entry fees for four events would be about \$560, or about \$56 per player for a team with 10 players.

Teams are able to access practice time through the KBC Travel Team Program. There are minimal fees per team which includes uniforms, basketballs, practice times and insurance! Teams can practice one or two times per week, depending on the preference of the parents and coach.

Usually there are three to four boys teams per grade formed, and two or three girls teams. The most important part of a travelling team is finding a parent or two willing to organize it (which is not difficult).

Tournament entry forms for various tournaments will be out in the fall. It is important to be organized by early September so the team can be included in the KBC practice schedule for mid-October thru December. Teams that get organized a little later will be included in the January thru March schedule.
